1907 - Northern Baptist Societies coalesce into the Northern Baptist Convention.

> 1911 - Freewill Baptists merge with Northern Baptists.

> > 1913 - Northern Baptists accept charter membership in Federal Council of Churches of Christ in United States.

> > > 1915 - In rift with the National Baptists, Richard H. Boyd organizes National Baptist Convention of America.

> > > > 1920 - Curtis Lee Laws coined the term "Fundamentalism"

1920 - Fundamental Baptist Fellowship first met in June in Buffalo, N.Y.

> 1922 - Formation of the Baptist Bible Union

1930 - World Fundamental Missionary Fellowship

> 1932 - GARBC formed out of wreckage of BBU.

1942-1957 - rise of the New Evangelical movement outside Baptist circles but involving and impacting Baptist groups.

1943 -Formation of the Conservative Baptist Foreign Mission Society within the NBC.

1947 - Conservative Baptist Association formed.

1950 - Birth of the Baptist Bible Fellowship out of the World Baptist Fellowship (split from J. Frank Norris).

> 1955-1956 - bus boycott in Birmingham, following Rosa Parks' protest, led by liberal Baptists MLK, Jr. and Ralph Abernathy

1961 - Formation of the World Conservative Baptist Mission to serve Independent, Fundamental Baptist Churches. (renamed Baptist World Mission, 1966.)

> 1968 - anti-war young protestors in SBC formed Baptist Students Concerned in Raleigh, NC.

> > 1976 - Harold Lindsell publishes *The Battle for the Bible*, partly due to concerns regarding rising liberalism in the SBC and other evangelical groups.

1979 - election of Adrian Rogers as president of SBC, opening salvo in the Conservative Resurgence.

1991 - formation of progressive Cooperative Baptist Fellowship as a marker of conservative victory in the SBC Conservative Resurgence.

# Issues facing Baptists into the 21st Century:

- 1. Charismatic movement
- 2. Evolving Worship Styles
- 3. Resurgent Calvinism
- 4. Threats to religious liberty, especially due to Islamic violence and aggressive homosexual agendas.

# Issues facing independent fundamentalist Baptists:

- 1. Increasing pressure of the world on worship
- 2. Increasing pressure of seemingly attractive conservative evangelicals (lack of historical awareness, valuing seeming evang. success)
- 3. Weakening collective strength due to division over peripherals (like versions and legalism).
